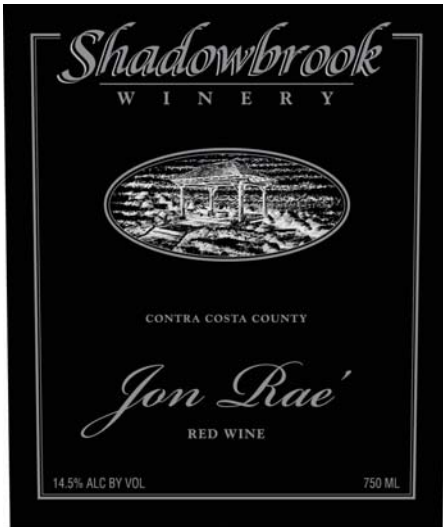

Our Jon Rae is a special blend of red wines in tribute to the winemaker's fathers, John Lavezzoli and Ray Jochner. This wine is created to express the quality of Walnut Creek "terroir" year after year. It exhibits aromas of **ripe blackberries, vanilla** and **cassis** on the nose. On the palate it has a smooth layered texture with additional dark **berry**, and **chocolate mocha** flavors, followed by a mouth covering finish, smooth tannins that leave the taste of toasted **marshmallows** and **caramel** on your palate.

Winemaker's Comments:

Like all of Shadowbrook's award winning wines, our grapes are meticulously farmed, hand picked and carried to our Walnut Creek winery, manually sorted and crushed. Fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks and the wine is aged in new 100% French Oak barrels for 17 months.

Shadowbrook Winery:

The Mount Diablo area has a long history of grape growing, with vineyards comprising approximately one third of the area's agriculture in the early 20th century. But with the onset of prohibition in the 1920s, orchards of walnuts and almonds replaced this profitable grape crop. Shadowbrook Winery, Walnut Creek's first winery since prohibition, grows their grapes in the foothills of Mount Diablo and meticulously produces premium wines for discerning wine connoisseurs returning Walnut Creek to its roots as the preeminent wine producer.

60% Cabernet, 12% Merlot, 10% Syrah, 10% Malbec, 5% Cabernet Franc and 3% Petit Sirah

AGING: Seventeen Months, 100% French Oak, 70% New

ALCOHOL: 14.5%
